



Fete Tickets

Tickets are now on sale for our first Summer Fete! You can purchase tickets from the school playground before or after school this week, or from the main office. Tickets cost £3



per adult (children go free). You will receive 3 x tokens with your ticket, which you can use to buy items at the fete or participate in some of the games or activities available. Additional tokens will be available to buy on the day for £1 per token; special offers of £5 for 6 tokens and £10 for 12 tokens will also be available!



Transition Morning

Children and staff are all very much looking forward to our transition morning this Wednesday. Teachers have planned lots of fun activities for children to spend time getting to know each other and their new classroom environments. Current Reception and Y1 children should arrive at school at the normal time. New Reception children will be coming into school at 9.30am. Parents and carers can escort children up to the classrooms with staff if they wish, and spend up to 30 minutes in the classroom. A welcome session and refreshments for new parents will then be held in the hall until 11am.

School Caterers Next Year

Following an extensive process across our Trust schools, we are delighted to announce that a new catering service has been secured for September. **Caterlink** will be providing all school meals, which will be cooked in our fabulous kitchen, on site, from September! There will be opportunities for parents and carers to come in and sample some of the menu items next year and we will, of course, publish the new menus once they have been confirmed. Caterlink will provide high quality, nutritious, delicious and freshly cooked meals every day, and staff will assist with our family-dining style service at lunchtimes. If there is a medical or specific need for your child to bring in a packed lunch, please arrange a meeting with Mrs Stephens, who will coordinate with the school nurse as necessary. Written approval from the school's Senior Leadership Team is required for any children bringing in a packed lunch.

All your fundraising efforts will go towards this project this year.

ASCs for Autumn Term

Timetables for, and full details of, Autumn ASCs will be sent to all families this week. You will be able to secure a place in your preferred clubs using our new booking system, which will go live before the end of term. You will need to book your child's place on ParentPay at a cost of £1. Once the club is fully booked, it will be removed from ParentPay and will no longer be available. The Extended Schools Team will then assign your child to relevant club/s you have chosen and the £1 booking fee will be deducted from the total cost of the club. Club fees must be paid **in full for the whole term, in advance**, before the club commences. After School Clubs and After Care start in week 3 of the Autumn term.
