We now have carpet on the second floor! Blinds have also been added to windows on the remaining floors. Building works continue apace and will do so throughout the half term break; you will have recently noticed our very smart new signage on our internal front doors and underneath the office desk area.



Our outdoor areas are due for completion by 09/11/15 – recent spells of bad weather have made it difficult to complete waterproofing on the roof itself and the third floor terrace, but we are very excited about seeing the proposed play surface design (below) taking shape! The terrace will come complete with retractable canopies, new safety barriers (half-painted wooden cladding, half reinforced frosted glass), window boxes for plants and lots of other items that we are sure will appeal to our children!
