

So what is it...?



Fortnite is an online game where players do not have to pay to play. In Battle Royal, 100 players compete against each other to be the last person standing.

It has a PEGI rating of 12, for 'frequent scenes of mild violence'

The game has a cartoonish style, and the violence, while persistent, isn't bloody or particularly gory (only guns).



National Crime Agency...

...has warned Fortnite is putting children at risk from online paedophiles

Because voice and text chats between players cannot be turned off, parents may be unaware their children are chatting to strangers online

March 2018, a mother from Merseyside told how she intervened when her 12-year-old son was offered £50 to perform "sex acts" while playing the game by a man grooming him online.

WhatsApp is an instant messaging app, which lets you send instant messages, images and videos to friends.




Viber

Viber lets you text, call, share photos and send video messages to people worldwide.




Tango

Discord is the only cross-platform voice and text chat app designed specifically for gamers. It is perfect for chatting with team member and seeing who is playing online





24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year	Face -to-Face
No safe place, often very hard to escape	Can find a safe place, find an escape
Bully can be anonymous. Hard to know who the Bully is	Bully can be identified
Harder to empathise with the victim. Can't always see the victims reaction	Can see body & facial reactions from the victim and onlookers



What should I do if my child is being bullied online? 

Stay calm

Listen without judging

Praise them for talking to you

Tell them you can help

Ask them not to reply

Block the bullies

Keep the evidence

How do offenders engage youngsters?
 – by using the sites that they use...



Often posing as a child of the same age / gender. They will often purposefully present a very similar profile as the child. They are skilled at manipulating them into criminal sexual relationships

Online grooming: The five stages

Friendship

1

Flattering a child
 into talking in a private chatroom/game where they will be isolated
 The child will often be asked for a non-sexual picture of themselves

Online grooming: The five stages

Forming a relationship

2

Gaining information
 asking the child what problems /needs they have to create the illusion of being their best friend and that they can help
 They begin to fill the needs of the child

Online grooming: The five stages

Risk assessment

3

Asking the child about the location of their computer/tablet and **who else has access to it**
 in order to assess the risk of being detected. The desire is to **create situations where they are alone together**
 to help reinforce a ***special connection***

Online grooming: The five stages

Exclusivity

4


Building up a sense of ***mutual love and trust with the child***
 suggesting that they can discuss "anything"

Online grooming: The five stages

Sex talk / Meet

5

Engaging the child in explicit conversations & **requesting sexually explicit pictures from them**
 At this stage the predator will usually try to ***arrange a meeting with the child***



Man pretending to be boy to pester young girls is jailed

A man who pretended to be a 14-year-old schoolboy and pestered young girls to send naked photos of themselves has been jailed.



Mark Taft Credit: Nottinghamshire Police

Mark Taft used social media to contact girls aged between 12 and 17. He engaged in sexual

Mark Taft (27) used Facebook under a fake account of a child who he called Luke Carlisle

Sentenced to 3 years, 3 months in prison

Also given a Sexual Harm Prevention Order and will sign the Sex Offenders Register for life



Teaching assistant jailed for grooming teenagers online

19 May 2017



Baker persuaded five teenage boys to share explicit photos of themselves on Facebook.

A teaching assistant who tricked five boys into sending him explicit photos of themselves has been jailed.

Stuart Baker, 40, lured his victims into sexual conversations by posing as a 14-year-old girl on Facebook.

Sentenced to 3 years in prison.

The court was told that the youngest victim was 13 and that one had been suffering from "extreme anxiety" as a result of the abuse.



Christopher Hodder jailed for Facebook grooming of boys

13 March 2017



Hodder had been sentenced to 18 months in prison for grooming.

A "perverted monster" who hunted out and sexually groomed 13 boys on Facebook has been jailed for four years.

Christopher Hodder set up a fake online profile and pretended to be a girl as he lured his victims into providing intimate images of themselves.

Hodder, 31, from Kirby Stephen in Cumbria, admitted 18 offences at Carlisle Crown Court.

The father of one of his victims said the family's lives had been ruined.

The man said: "This perpetrator should never be allowed to walk the streets again."

Christopher Hodder (31) sexually groomed 13 boys on Facebook by posing as a girl.

Sentenced to 4 years in prison.

The court heard Hodder had been sentenced for a previous grooming crime in 2013. Part of his punishment was not to contact any children aged under 16 via the internet.

Fears over fake Bieber and Styles accounts



Law enforcement officers have been warning BBC Trending radio about a growing number of social media accounts wrongly purporting to be both the Harry Styles and Justin Bieber, sparking inappropriate use by young children.

The growing world of social media apps with big teenage audiences has made the situation even more difficult for police, they say.

Law enforcement have warned about Musical.ly (and similar apps) pretending to be idols like Harry Styles & Justin Bieber



"Lots of child sex offenders are utilising Musical.ly to groom children"

...said Inspector Jon Rouse.



MAKING THINGS SAFER

Tips for parents....

- Create boundaries and rules for the amount of time child can spend online. It's never too early to start putting limits in place.
- The rules and conversations you have now will set the tone for your child's internet use as they get older.
- Always worth checking the videos, apps and games children use, and the age ratings and descriptions for them.

The disturbing YouTube videos that are tricking children

Thousands of videos on YouTube look like the versions of popular cartoons but contain disturbing and inappropriate content not suitable for children.

If you're not paying much attention, it might look like an ordinary video featuring Peppa Pig, the cheeky porcine star of her own animated series. But soon after pressing play on this particular YouTube clip, the plot turns dark. A dentist with a huge syringe appears. Peppera's teeth get pulled out. Distressed crying can be heard on the soundtrack.

Videos on YouTube that seem to be the favourite cartoons of children - but are not.

"Peppera does a lot of screaming and crying and the dentist is just a bit sadistic and it's just way, way off what a three-year-old should watch" said one Mother.

The Kids Search, search engine is highly sensitive

- Use a strong password
- Use an alias and avoid personal pictures
- Don't include date of birth and other personal information
- Show your child how to block and report
- Change settings to private
- Consider the minimum age
- Don't accept friend requests from strangers
- Switch off location services
- Tell them to think before they post

1. Open the Family Link app Family Link.
2. Select your child.
3. On the "Settings" card, tap Manage Settings and then Controls on Google Play.
4. Tap the type of content you want to filter.
5. Choose how to filter or restrict access.

Simple checklist for parents:

- I have visited www.thinkuknow.co.uk with my child (I have bookmarked the CEOP website and told my child what is there)
- Open and honest dialogue - show an interest and learn about what your child does online
- Stay in control as much as you can through parental filters, Family Sharing, and apps like Screen Limit
- Advertise yourself as one of the people your child can turn to - without being chastised...
- Education is better than saying to your child "you are not doing this anymore..."
