
Halley House School Disco!

Year 3 Payment for Dinners

As you will know, Universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM) are not available to children in Years 3 to 6. Parents of children currently in Year 2 will need to start paying for your child's school lunch from September. The cost per day will be £2.20. This must be paid half termly in advance on ParentPay. This does not apply to children who are eligible for Free School Meals (FSM). If you have

any queries about arrangements in September, please do pop into the office and speak to us.
