


## Computing

## Literacy


Year 3 have enjoyed reading fictional books on Ancient Egypt such as 'Anthony and Cleopatra' and 'Tutankhamun'.

This term, we will be reading a new fiction book called 'Bill's New Frock'. In this story, the main character wakes up to find out he'll be wearing a dress to school. Bill is about to discover that everything is very different for girls... We will be covering topics around gender stereotype and exploring life from a different perspective.

We will also be looking at how we can use a variety of language to engage our readers through our writing texts. We will continue to reinforce the use of paragraphs, clauses, similes or metaphors, varied starters and fronted adverbials to help bring our own stories to life!




## Mathematics

In Maths, we will be learning to tell the time to 1 minute intervals, using 24 hour clocks and Roman Numerals—any extra practice as you are out and about will help to reinforce this learning too. This is a key skill that the children will use every day so a great one to keep ticking over (pardon the pun)!

We will then move on to Mass and Capacity before consolidating our knowledge of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division to give us a great start to Year 4.

Please continue practicing 2,3,4,5, 6, 8 and 10 times tables at home. There are lots of games online that allow the children to work on different times tables and they are key to increasing the children's confidence and fluency in all areas of maths.



## Topic

This term we will continue our topic of 'Birth of Civilisation'. We will investigate the life, society and culture of Ancient Egypt by researching using secondary sources and exploring different mediums.



We will also be consolidating our understanding of a range of scientific topics by working scientifically. We will identify that animals, including humans, need the right amount of nutrition. We will be exploring how animals get their food and nutrition. In addition, Year 3, will explore the bones and muscles in both animals and humans. They will learn how muscles are used for support, protection and movement.



## Physical Education

In Physical Education, we will continue with swimming sessions. During the sessions, children will be practising to develop various strokes such as breaststroke, back stroke and front crawl.

During our sessions at Petchy Academy, we will be practising and building on our athletic skills. Our skills needed for our throwing events—we will be preparing ourselves for Sports Day!
