



Heroes



Literacy

This half term the children will be taking part in games and activities that encourage listening and comprehension as well as supporting early writing, this includes listening games, sharing our favourite stories and games using Fred from our Read, write inc. programme.

We will mark making in cornflour and using cotton buds to do painting.



Mathematics

We will participating in number songs and also describing a sequence of events using real words such as 'first', 'then' and 'next'.

We will also be using shapes to create and collaborate with, including using flat surfaces for buildings and a triangular prism for a roof.



Physical Development

We will be exploring activities that support our fine motor and gross motor skills, including making superhero necklaces, playdough cupcakes, using push and pull toys and the large wooden blocks to create cars and vehicles.

Personal Development

We will be taking part in adult-led keyworker sessions, where we will take part in What's in the bag games to develop our listening and attention skills.

We will be continuing to work on our independence for meeting our own needs and will continue to use the dojo point system to reward our daily achievements.
